The Manetti Shrem Museum depends on the Student Coalition for advice, ideas, and hands-on engagement to be a relevant, useful, and exciting space for the UC Davis student body.

Who

The Manetti Shrem Museum Student Coalition is a volunteer group of UC Davis students that actively shapes the student experience at the museum. As a group you will have the opportunity to plan parties and programs, create zines/blogs, and anything else you can think of for the UC Davis student body to enjoy and connect to our community space!

What

At meetings, you will come up with ideas for museum to student outreach to get the word out! As a team you plan activities that will bring more students to the museum. You will have and get to share the most up to date information on jobs, internships, and opportunities to join the museum family. The Student Coalition follows the Principals of Community and seeks to support and have participation from a diversity of students across major, age, ability, race, and gender.

When & Where

The Coalition meets twice a month on Tuesdays from 4-6pm at the museum during the academic year with the added opportunity to contribute to a 24/7 accessible online discussion. With roughly 4-5 meetings every quarter, members should attend a minimum of 80% of the in-person meetings throughout the year.

In-person meetings will be two hours long and are open to the entire UC Davis student community to contribute options. Only members of the Coalition are able to take on leadership roles in projects. There is no hierarchy in the Coalition - as projects arise, different members can volunteer their time as their schedule allows.
